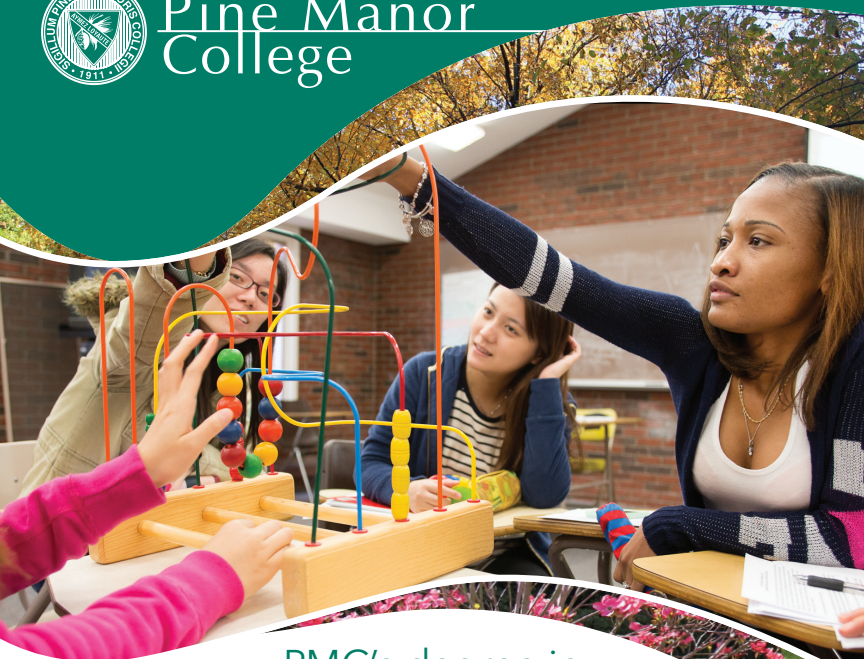

Psychology

The Psychology major is a way to gain understanding of yourself and others through the study of the social, developmental, cognitive, and biological causes of behavior. The department prides itself on providing students with an applied approach to psychology through the study of current research and theories in the field. Psychology majors select one of four concentrations: General Psychology, Expressive Therapies, Human Services or Organizational Psychology. Psychology students learn psychological theory and conduct practical research with community partners. They participate in service-learning projects and off-campus learning experiences, as well as intern at a number of local organizations and schools. In the research practicum, students work with community partners to design and implement a research project. Through this action-oriented and experiential class, students work collaboratively and gain invaluable experience in the community.
