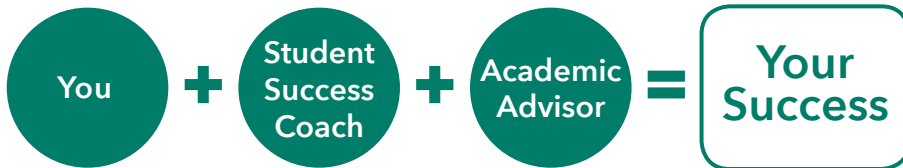

ACCESSIBILITY SERVICES

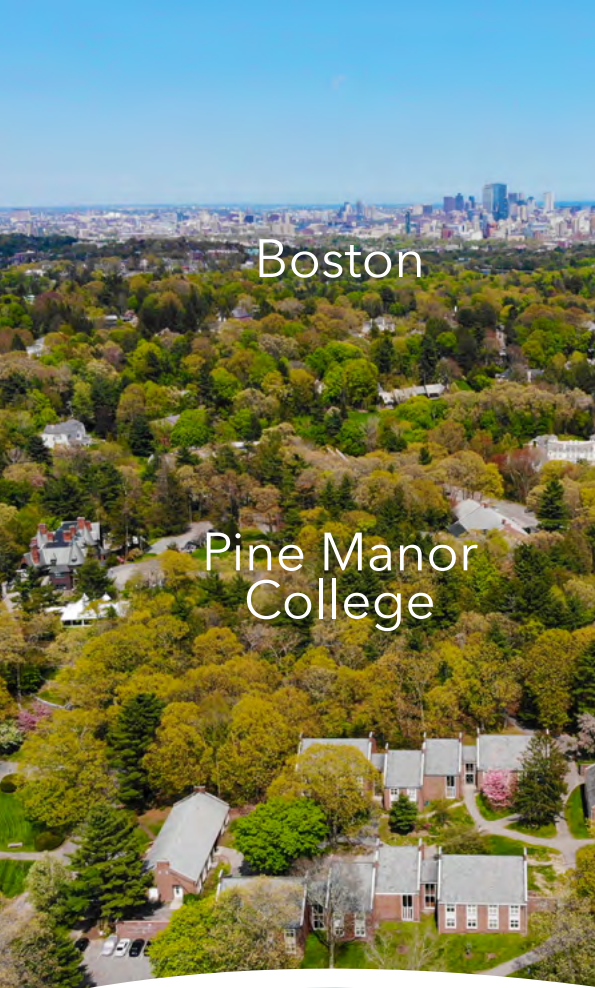

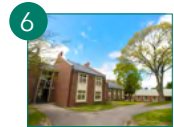
